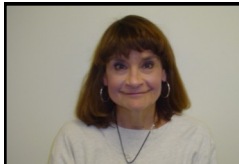

Our staff has experience with a wide range of mental health issues affecting children and adults. These issues include ADHD, mood and anxiety, grief and loss, and relationship issues.

Patients are active in their recovery. Sessions focus on the strengths and abilities patients have to cope with their issues.

We assist patients in their progress. We also have court approved divorce mediation and parent education.

Our staff provides referrals to other specialists for people who have substance abuse or eating disorders.
