Sec. 7-9.

(3) B. Any owner of a dog found to be dangerous as pursuant to the Illinois Animal Control Act and who permits such dog to run at large is in violation of the Illinois Animal Control Act and subject to a fine of at least \$100.00. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during which a violation occurs.

(3) C. Any owner of a dog ordered to impound such dog pursuant to this chapter who fails to abide by the impoundment order within 24 hours shall be in violation of the Illinois Animal Control Act and this chapter and subject to a fine of at least \$100.00. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day said dog is not impounded.

Illinois Animal Control Act

(510 ILCS 5/2.05a)

Sec. 2.05a. "Dangerous dog" means (i) any individual dog anywhere other than upon the property of the owner or custodian of the dog and unmuzzled, unleashed, or unattended by its owner or custodian that behaves in a manner that a reasonable person would believe poses a serious and unjustified imminent threat of serious physical injury or death to a person or a companion animal or (ii) a dog that, without justification, bites a person and does not cause serious physical injury.
