General Summary of Duties:

This position will conduct and document a comprehensive behavioral health assessment for each patient, provide evidence-based screenings and treatment for patients in school system and at the Clinic and conduct appropriate referrals specific to each patient. The Therapist will provide constructive suggestions and recommendations to improve overall school-based behavioral healthcare and conduct community education groups.

- Experience with school-based counseling services preferred, but not required
