General Summary of Duties:

Acting as an independent healthcare provider working collaboratively within a multidisciplinary health team, the nurse Practitioner is responsible for providing comprehensive care to both well and ill patients. This position will educate patients and/or their families in order to promote wellness, prevent health problems, prevent unintended pregnancies, maintain current health and intervene in acute or chronic illness.
